### 1. Palacký English Programme Association

# 2. Keep it fair

Students are advised that due to repeated cases of cheating during exams, a new measure has been introduced, by which any such events will be recorded in writing by respective teachers and the faculty management will always be notified. Please note that such behaviour is in breach of the University Study and Examination Code as well as the Contract each student signs at the beginning of his/her studies.

#### 3. Waste collection fee

All foreign students residing in Olomouc have an obligation to pay an annual waste collection fee. The fee amounts to CZK 660 per year and for 2017 should be paid by May 31. Your payment can either be made in cash at the Municipal Office at Palacký 14, Olomouc or via bank transfer to the following account no.: 19-1801731369/0800, variable symbol: 1337, specific symbol: your date of birth in DDMMYYY format. Your name should also be stated as payment reference.

#### 4. Summer internships

Students of General Medicine from the second year onwards and students of Dentistry from the first year onwards have various summer clinical trainings as part of their curricula. You have the option of completing the trainings in your home country over the summer. If you decide to do so, please remember that you must have a contract signed with the hospital, where you will be completing you training, and you are obliged to deliver it to the faculty prior to starting the training. You have the option of applying for a financial contribution for trainings done outside the Czech Republic. Such contribution can only be paid out once during your period of studies. You may be eligible for the contribution if you fulfil the following criteria:

- The training will be minimum 30 days long, completed without interruption
- A contract with the hospital will be delivered to the faculty as stated above

## 5. Exceptional scholarship 2017

The Faculty of Medicine and Dentistry announces the call for submitting applications for exceptional scholarship 2017 supporting the international mobility of its students. The call applies to students who carry out an internship/international mobility lasting at least 30 days during the year 2017 (especially IFMSA).

Note: this is not the same as the financial contribution from the Faculty for your summer (obligatory) internships outside the Czech Republic (see above).

**June 30, 2017** – start of electronic registration of courses for students with all courses from the 2016/2017 academic year completed (and recorded in the system) by this date

July 27, 2017 – start of electronic registration of courses for all other students

September 04, 2017 – deadline for completing courses for the 2016/2017 academic year
