Do not forget that there are some obligatory subjects which should be completed during summer months. Please see the list below:

Students doing their internships abroad must submit agreements on the provision of student internship before the start of the internship. Moreover, if you want to receive the financial contribution from the Faculty, make sure the internship lasts at least 30 days.

4. Study evaluation

Study evaluation forms will be available in June. Students may submit the completed forms at registration to the following year in September. Final year students are kindly asked to submit the evaluation forms before their graduation ceremony on June 22, 2015.

5. Vice-Dean's meetings with students

Based on the Vice-Dean's meetings with students we would like to inform you that students' suggestions are taken into consideration and continuously dealt with. Here are some conclusions resulting from students' inquires:

- First and last year students with the best study results (according to CGPA) will be awarded certificates during the matriculation and graduation ceremonies.
- Situation at the Department of Anatomy has been stabilized; a new guarantor responsible for teaching in English programmes is prof. Ehrmann.
- Operating rules for the faculty facilities will be prepared.
- Electric appliances such as microwave ovens and kettles are not available for students and staff at common areas.
- A section with updates from the faculty webpages will be included in the new website.
- Language competence of students and medical staff will be discussed with the heads of the departments.
