1. Selection procedure requirements for undergraduate students

1. Students have to be registered in the accredited study programme of General Medicine or Dentistry
2. Completion of 3rd year of study prior to study abroad
3. Good results
4. Language skills
5. Extra-curricular activities will be taken into account
6. Students who have not yet attended a study-stay within the LLP Erasmus/Erasmus+ programmes will be preferred
7. Creating a preliminary study plan for each of the chosen foreign institutions for which the student applies (please make sure you choose subjects for at least 20 credits per semester)
8. Submission of all required documents (application form, confirmations, preliminary study plans) within the deadline specified in the selection procedure
9. Students planning to go to the country of their origin will be given lower priority; please be aware of one of the programme rules: Students must carry out their mobility activity in a Programme or Partner Country different from the country of the sending organisation and the country where the student has his/her accommodation during his/her studies

Applicants for the selection procedure will be assessed according to the following criteria. Students with the highest score will be offered to select the study-stays of choice.

Rules of the selection procedure for undergraduate students

1. Grades – cumulative grade point average (CGPA)

- CGPA for completed academic years
- 100 points divided by CGPA

2. Language

- Scores: A (45 points), B (40 points), C (30 points), D (20 points), E (10 points)
- For Czech students, the test result of the English/German language course shall be used to calculate the respective scores in case of study stays at universities where these languages are required.
- For other languages of the study-stay course (French, Portuguese, Spanish, German or English), the respective language exam results will be considered.
- For an applicant desirous of study-stay courses at several universities encompassing different languages of instruction, all languages shall be assessed separately.
- +15 points will be awarded for knowledge of the local language where English is the language of instruction (e.g. Hungarian, etc.)
- Language exam dates will be specified by the respective examiners and exams will take place prior to the selection procedure.
- Students, who passed the language examination for the Erasmus selection procedures in previous years, do not have to take the exam again. The result from the last years will be taken into account.
- Students of the English programmes have to sit an exam in the language of instruction of the receiving institution; this requirement is not valid for native speakers who will automatically get 45 points.

3. Active work in student organizations (ESN, IFMSA, PEPA, Spolek mediků, SSS ČR): +10 points

2. Selection procedure requirements for postgraduate students

1. Students have to be registered in the accredited postgraduate study programme
2. CV, motivation letter and recommendation from their tutor by the deadline specified in the selection procedure

How to apply:

Applicants are required to fill in the application in the Erasmus+ online platform (available at erasmusplus.upol.cz). Please perform the following steps:

1. Use the same login and password as you use for the Portal.
2. Check, if all the personal and contact details are correct. Change what needs to be corrected. Do not forget to fill in the additional information ("doplňující údaje") at the right hand side column: length of university studies; number of months in case you already went to an Erasmus+ study-stay; cycle of studies – master ("magisterský") or Ph.D. ("doktorský").
3. Chose the institutions you prefer: the preferred semester, your degree programme, university, language. If you apply to more universities, indicate your preferences for each of them.
4. Submit your application.
5. Print out the application form, sign it and hand it in together with all the required attachments to Petra Nakládalová (Student Department).

Application deadline: **January 26, 2018.**

The selection procedure shall be held at the Theoretical Institutes, lecture room no. 2.517 on **February 8, 2018** at 15.00.
